

Report: African Diaspora Youth in Sweden.

A report on African Diasporan Youth in Sweden reveals that though they are generally satisfied with the quality of their lives here, they feel neglected and invisible in the political arena. The report, which includes a survey on how African Diasporans feel they are treated in schools, health care, the police and other public bodies, contains a survey that grades treatment by public institutions from "good" to "bad". The report describes the seminars, activities, results of the project and a list of co-operative organisations in Malmö and Lund. It concludes with a list of recommendations for the Swedish government and NGOs to implement. The project, entitled The African Diasporans in Sweden, was supported by a grant from the The Swedish National Board for Youth Affairs (Ungdomsstyrelsen). It is only available in Swedish.
